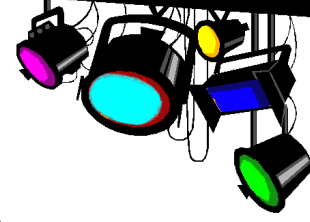
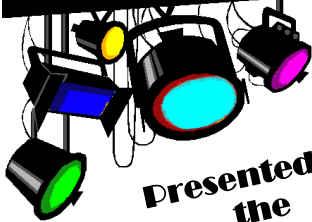

<p>Who:</p>	<p>Children entering 3rd grade through 8th grade as of September 2025.</p> <p>Participants spend half the day in rehearsal and half the day in interactive workshops on theatre-related topics taught by local experts and program staff. Informal, non-stressful auditions are held during the first week of the program; every participant is placed within this year’s production, <i>Alice in Wonderland Jr.</i> <u>Due to the collaborative nature of producing a show, we are not able to accept children who will miss more than two days due to planned absences.</u></p>		
<p>What:</p>	<p>This program provides arts enrichment in a nurturing, safe, and fun environment, culminating in a full-scale theatrical production. Participants are placed in age-appropriate groups supervised by high school and college-age counselors under the direction of adult professionals. The focus is on arts education, group cooperation, and fun!!!</p>
